

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT POSTERS

All poster materials should be prepared in advance and ready to be set up at least 10 min. before the beginning of the scheduled class session according to number assigned. The author should be available to answer questions. Thumbtacks will be provided. Please remove your poster as soon as the session is over so that the next presenter may readily use the space.

Requirements for Making Posters

The poster board surface is white, 3' 10" high by 4' 10" wide. [if possible]

Posters should be easy to read and not crowded. They should contain the following:

1. **Title** (at least 1 1/2 inches high)
2. **Name of author**- at least 1" high
For example:
a) John Doe '99 – Worcester State College
3. Generally, for studies in the physical, biological and social sciences, the main body of the poster consists of: **abstract, introduction, method (subjects, procedure), results, discussion, illustrations** (tabular and/or graphic) which are used to support major points of the text (lettering should be at least 3/8 inch high).
4. As a courtesy to other participants in the class, it is suggested that an **abstract or reprint of the poster presentation** be available for distribution on request.
